We have now upon the statute-book, Mr. Speaker, the acts of 1795 and of 1807. Under these laws the President has ample authority to call out the regular military power of the country, in case of invasion or danger of invasion from any foreign nation or Indian tribe; also, in case of insurrection in any State against the Government thereof - in which case he shall act only upon the call of the Legislature of such State, if in session: or if not in session, then upon the call of the Governor. He has also the same power whenever the laws of the United States shall be opposed, or the...
